Discuss:

- > What do the scriptures for this section say that you have not seen before?
- > Why did Jesus teach in Parables?
- > What is the difference between *Hearing* and *Listening*?
- ➤ What does all this mean?

Read Together: Matthew 13:19 (NLT)

Discuss:

- > What does the scripture for this section say that you have not seen before?
- > What is the condition of the soil of your heart?
- > Is your heart hard? How does God want to meet you in that hardness?

Read Together: Matthew 13:20-21 (NLT)

Discuss:

- > What does the scripture for this section say that you have not seen before?
- ➢ Is your heart shallow?
- ▶ What causes you to waiver in your faith?

Read Together: Matthew 13:22 (NLT)

Discuss:

- > What does the scripture for this section say that you have not seen before?
- Is your heart strangled?

- ➤ What is your biggest worry?
- > How can you return to peace when you begin to worry?

Read Together: Matthew 13:23 (NLT) **Discuss:**

- > What does the scripture for this section say that you have not seen before?
- ➢ Is your heart soft?
- > Where are you seeing fruit-bearing in and around your life?

Pray:

- Ask God to show you the type of soil you have in your heart.
- If you have multiple types of soil in your heart, ask God to show you what is hard and ask Him to bring a softness there.
- Ask God to help your unbelief so He can make changes in the soil of your heart.
- Where there is soft, fertile soil, ask God to bear fruit that will remain to bring Him Glory.
