

## The Parable of the Elder Brother

**Icebreaker:** Hot Cocoa or Hot Apple Cider?

**Read Together:** Luke 15:25-32 (NIV)

**Discuss:** 

- ➤ What do you see that you have not noticed before in the scripture for this section?
- ➤ Both boys were in Rebellion. Different ways of showing it. Older Brother syndrome.
- ➤ How dare you use your resources in a way that I don't agree with?
- ➤ They both wanted the stuff of the Father without the relationship with the Father.

**Read Together:** Luke 15:25-32 (NIV)

**Discuss:** Symptoms of "the elder brother syndrome"

- Projects judgment towards others and God.
- Inflated view of their own righteousness.
- Misunderstanding of God's grace.
- ➤ Do you make excuses for the acts of your flesh?
- > Do you find that others say you are blinded to anything except your own feelings?
- > Do you find yourself thinking that you deserve better than another person?
- > Do you ever notice yourself trying to earn your own righteousness?
- ➤ Do you ever ask for stuff from the Father without pursuing a relationship with the Father?

**Read Together:** Matthew 20:8-15 (The Message)

**Discuss:** The loving father's message to the elder brother.

- What part of this scripture for this section sounds like the Older Brother?
- ➤ Do you struggle to recognize that God cherishes YOU, not your works?
- ➤ The Brothers both wanted the stuff of the Father without the relationship with the Father. How often do you see that in the church?
- > Our Position in Christ gives us all that He has as ours. How do you take that?
- ➤ God wants you to enjoy His party. Are you able to rejoice with Him when He celebrates another person?
- Are you going to go to the party or will you stay outside and wallow in judgment toward God?

> We don't know how the story ended!! How does that settle in your spirit?

## **Pray:**

- Ask God to help you rejoice when He rejoices.
  Ask God to give you grace for others that you do not like.
  Ask God to give you contentment that Knowing Jesus, means you have everything that the Father has as well.
