Read together: 2 Timothy 3:14-17 (NIV), Hebrews 4:12 (ESV), Psalm 119:105 (ESV) **Discuss:**

- ➤ How do we keep our worldview biblical?
 - o Stand in awe of His word. How do you value God's breath?
 - o *Kneel in submission to His word*. What parts of God's word that you struggle with?
 - Walk in the illumination of His word. How do you apply principles of God's word to areas of living that the Bible does not address specifically?
